MLFTU Requirement Checklist

To participate and utilize the MLFTU training, the following is required:

As per the regulations of the OFM and OFC,

Prior to being permitted to participate in live fire training evolutions, the student shall have received training to meet the minimum job performance requirements for Fire Fighter 1 in NFPA 1001 related to the following subjects:

- o Safety
- o Fire behaviour
- o Portable extinguishers
- Personal protective equipment (PPE)
- o Ladders
- Fire hose, appliances and streams
- o Overhaul
- o Water supply
- o Ventilation
- o Forcible entry
- o Building Construction

Other Requirements Needed:

- Certified Bunker Gear (10 years or less) we have some spare gear if needed.
- Mask Fit Test (within 2 years April 25th, 2023)
- o Shaven to the approved facial hair grid below

Please ensure that these are sent ahead of time or a copy of proof to be brought for the OFM – MLFTU instructors upon arrival. Without the above requirements, they will not allow you to participate in the training.

We have attached a Bunker and SCBA inspection utilized by one of our departments if it helps.

If you would like to book and schedule a time for use on these days, the following is required as per the OFC:


A safety plan will be required for training evolutions. A template is attached with this email if needed. OFC Instructors will ensure the training safety plan is completed prior to training. If you have an existing documentation, feel free to use it. The TSP will need to be reviewed and approved by the OFC Operators, prior to training.

All training will follow the intent of NFPA 1403 – Standard for Live Fire Training Evolutions. This will require a designated Lead Instructor, Training Safety Officer, and a qualified RIT team of at least two competent firefighters supplied by the fire department. Any functional (operating) crew must not exceed 5 students per competent instructor.
